#### Friday 15<sup>th</sup> February

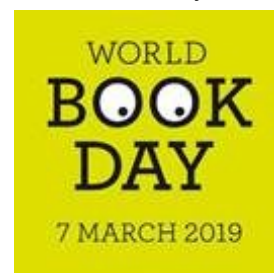
The Friday before half term is a non uniform day 15<sup>th</sup> February. The charity chosen is Children's Hospice South West.

Entry is £2.00 per child on the door to include sweets and a drink.

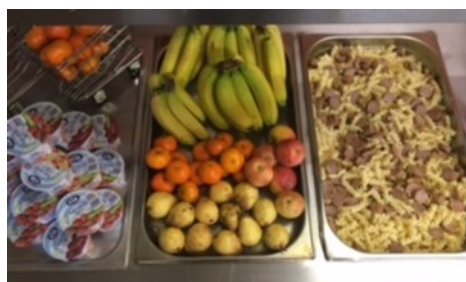
Children will need to bring the permission sheet to the disco. Children waiting to come in need to wait under the canopy, rather than the front door.
