Parents' Evenings

Hopefully you have all had the opportunity to speak with your child's teacher by phone or TEAMS to hear how they are getting on this term and have enjoyed looking at the sample of work they brought home or you saw on Tapestry (Reception and Year 1).

Christmas

We have been thinking about Christmas in school this year and with some adjustments we can still have some of the Christmas traditions.
