Parents' Evenings

You should have received a link in Parentmail to book a parent evening phone call or virtual meeting on Teams. We are running these over two weeks and the slots for each child are booked on line. The phone call / virtual meeting will give you the chance to hear from your child's teacher how your child is getting on at school and what areas in particular the teacher will be working on between now and March. Children will be able to share some pieces of work with you as they will bring home some copies of pieces from their books (years 1 to 6). Reception and Year 1 parents can see samples on their Tapestry accounts.

Arrangements in place due to Covid 19
